3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

EMERGENCY OVERVIEW: CEPACOL® Mouthwash - Regular is a yellow liquid with a characteristic odor. The solution is a combustible liquid. Direct contact with the eyes may cause irritation. Inhalation of high concentrations of vapors may cause respiratory irritation, dizziness and drowsiness.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

EYE: If contact occurs, flush eyes thoroughly with water, holding the eyelids open to assure thorough rinsing. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

SKIN: No first aid is anticipated to be needed.

INGESTION: In case of accidental ingestion, seek professional assistance or contact a Poison Control Center immediately.
