Gain hands-on experience in hairstyling, hair coloring, skin care/cosmetics, nail technology, and **MORE**. The training you receive will prepare you to take the New York State Cosmetology Examination to become a licensed cosmetologist.



Articulation agreements for college credit are in place with Bryant and Stratton College

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This is a two year program where students learn the latest techniques and apply them in our full service salon, which is open to the public. After students have successfully completed 1000 hours of cosmetology they are prepared to apply for licensing through New York State.

Objectives

1. To train students to meet the standards set forth by the State Education Department Cosmetology and Department of Licenses in skin care, hairstyling, haircutting, coloring, scalp and hair treatments, manicures, pedicures, artificial nails and hair removal.
2. To train students for gainful employment in the field of Cosmetology.
3. To develop in each student the self-confidence and positive attitude regarding their skills as a professional cosmetologist.
4. To encourage a sense of professionalism and high ethical standards.
5. To develop the job seeking employability skills necessary to succeed in the working world.

Units of Study

Sterilization and Sanitation, Skin Care and Cosmetics, Haircutting and Styling, Manicures and Pedicures, Shampoos, Scalp and Hair Treatments, Permanent Waving, Thermal Curling, Artificial Nails, Chemical Hair Reconstruction, Hair Color and Recolorization, Temporary Hair Removal, Salon Management and Ownership, NYS licensing preparation, Hair Extensions and Wigs.

Applied Academics

Students enrolled in the Cosmetology program can earn credits that will satisfy core academic requirements in English Language Arts, Math and Science. Through the integration of these core academics, achieving a Regents Diploma remains in reach.

College Agreements

In addition to gaining the skills needed to enter the workforce, this program provides an excellent foundation for students looking to enter a college program. Articulation agreements for college credit are in place with: Bryant and Stratton College (3 hours).
